

10 THINGS TO DO IN CADAQUES

1. Explore the Cap de Creus National Park

Discover the unique shapes of the rocks carved by wind and erosion, the multitude of plants and the special geological formations (Paratge de Tudela). Cap de Creus provides an ideal setting for hiking, cycling or boating. Head to Cap de Creus Lighthouse and have lunch or dinner at Cap de Creus Restaurant.

2. Visit the Dali Museum house in Port Lligat

Located just 5 minutes walking distance from Casa del Capitan, a visit to Dali's museum house is a must. Attracted by the beautiful light, Dali lived and worked in this lovely house for forty years. 3. Make a boat trip along the coast

Discover the wide range of beautiful beaches and coves with a rental boat or go for a tour with Gala's boat.

4. Visit the Santa Maria church in the old town

Wander around the old town and the charming cobbled streets up to highest point, Santa Maria church, where you will enjoy the wonderful view over the bay. The church has a long and interesting history and holds an amazing 18th c. baroque altarpiece.

5. Discover Cadaques art galleries

With such a rich artistic heritage, Cadaqués has attracted and inspired a large number of artists, many of whom settled in Cadaqués to exhibit their artistic talent. There is still a very important community of artists, and plenty of art galleries in the village.

6. Diner at the Compartir restaurant

Enjoy a delicious meal at Compartir, created and run by by three chefs from El Bulli. Excellent food in a warm & cozy atmosphere. Compartir means 'to share', so all dishes are meant to be shared between you and your guests. Advance booking essential.
